# Bicester Village

One standout example is the prestigious Bicester Shopping Village, where our robust Raj Green Sandstone was chosen for all hard landscaping. Enduring heavy foot traffic, this stone showcases not only its density but also its exceptional quality, maintaining its beauty against the test of time.





# Maasmechelen Shopping Village

At Maasmechelen Shopping Village, Brussels, our paving stones redefine elegance and durability. Withstanding heavy foot traffic, they epitomize enduring beauty, elevating the shopping experience to unmatched levels of sophistication.





# St Helens & St Katherines School

For this commercial building, we provided precise fabrication service for the bespoke staircases. The process involved digital templating of stainless steel structures, ensuring accuracy in every detail. The bespoke pieces were crafted to fit with the surrounding environment.

For the exterior & interior of this project, we used La Roche Pearl Limestone with a brushed and tumbled finished for flooring and custom staircases.





# Stone Lion

We took immense pride in creating four monumental stone lions for a prestigious project. By digitally scanning the original lions at Chatsworth House, we ensured precise replication. Using advanced technology, we reformatted the lions for a 360-degree viewing experience. Crafted from Massangis Limestone with our stone carving robot, each lion, 60% larger than the originals, stands as a testament to magnificence and precision.








# The Blessed Virgin Mary

Our specialist masonry expertise contributed to the creation of The Sculpture of The Blessed Virgin Mary of Lincoln in Lincoln Cathedral. Sculptor Aiden Hart commissioned us to fabricate a rough 7ft figure using our digital stone carving robot, followed by hand finishing and polychroming. The sculpture now graces Lincoln Cathedral, a magnificent testament to our collaboration.



# St Albans Cathedral

Our team collaborated on a meticulous project commissioned by ecclesiastical sculptor Rory Young. Using digital scanning and robotic stone carving, we produced perfect replicas of clay models. After initial polystyrene carving and stone sculpting, Rory meticulously finished the figures by hand. The sculptures were then polychromed and unveiled in St Albans Cathedral to celebrate its 900th anniversary in 2015.





# Old Swan Spa, Minster Lovell

Our ever-popular 'White Mint' Sandstone was chosen for this project, to create consistency throughout the flooring, inspection grilles, skirting, steps and windowsills. Spa copings were produced using 40mm Portuguese Alenjento Black granite with a large pencil roll. We fabricated hidden inspection covers for this client, ensuring a neat and seamless finish.





# The Crazy Bear, Stadhampton

We supplied Kota Brown sawn edge paving and hand-cut sets for pathways at The Crazy Bear in Stadhampton, Oxfordshire, enhancing its beauty and functionality. The earthy tones of Kota Brown stone create a Tuscan ambiance, ideal for commercial settings due to its durability and low maintenance. Additionally, our stepping stones and paving circles added further charm to the venue's garden area.





# The Queen's Stone

Our skilled masonry team has meticulously crafted a distinguished stone piece, paying tribute to the remarkable reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. This intricately designed commemorative stone stands as a testament to our dedication to preserving history and celebrating significant milestones with exquisite craftsmanship.
